POSITION SUMMARY:

The Department of Speech & Hearing Sciences at the University of New Mexico is conducting a search for an assistant professor. This is a 9-month, tenure-track appointment with a preferred start date of August 14, 2017. Responsibilities include conducting a research program consistent with the candidate's area of expertise, teaching undergraduate and graduate courses, mentoring students, and performing service duties. This is a probationary appointment leading to a tenure decision.

UNM is located in Albuquerque, New Mexico. Albuquerque is an eclectic, medium-sized city that enjoys many of the advantages of urban life with the addition of rich cultural diversity. Residents of Albuquerque enjoy a low cost of living in a beautiful desert and mountain biome. UNM holds a "Highest Research Activity" Carnegie Classification, includes a research and teaching hospital, and is a Hispanic-Serving Institution. The department has a collegial relationship with UNM's Department of Special Education as well as UNM's Center for Developmental Disabilities, the latter being the largest assessment and treatment center for autism in New Mexico. Senior faculty within the department provide mentoring to maximize research success.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Minimum qualifications include anticipated completion of doctorate before start date (August 14, 2017) in communication sciences and disorders or a related field.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants with a strong research trajectory are encouraged to apply, particularly those with a research specialty in autism or developmental disabilities in children or adults. A history of clinical or teaching experiences with individuals with autism or developmental disabilities is preferred, as well experience in teaching college-level courses. Applicants also should demonstrate commitment to diversity, equity, inclusion, and student success, as well as an ability to work with broadly diverse communities.

Submit a cover letter, CV, unofficial graduate academic transcripts, and the names and email addresses of three individuals willing to provide letters of reference. Applicant is required to provide an OFFICIAL certification of successful completion of all degree requirements prior to their initial employment with UNM.
